This award is given to a supportive adult who has gone above and beyond to support and/or improve the lives of young people in and from government care in BC.

ELIGIBILITY

- This person has demonstrated a high level of both commitment and skills and the knowledge required to work with young people in and from care in at least one of three categories: advocacy, community development or mentorship.
- More than 25 years old
- Lives in the province of British Columbia

REQUIRED DOCUMENT

- At least one reference letter (maximum three pages per reference letter) by a person less than 25 years old highlighting how this person has gone above and beyond for a young person in or from care in BC

SUGGESTED FOCUS OF REFERENCE LETTER

- Why does this person deserve this award?
- How has this supportive adult gone above and beyond for a young person in and from government care?
- How does this person lead, inspire or mentor young people in and from government care?
- How does this person improve the lives of young people in and from government care?
