REQUIRED DOCUMENT

- At least one reference letter (maximum three pages per reference letter) highlighting how this person has made significant self-improvements and has overcome personal obstacles.

SUGGESTED FOCUS OF REFERENCE LETTER

- Without disclosing too much personal information, describe how this person has overcome significant obstacles and demonstrated resiliency.
- How has this person overcome their obstacles in a healthy way?
- How has their personal experiences resulted in personal growth?
- In what ways has this person's resiliency inspired other people?
