Dear Youth Leadership Council,

Gabby and I are writing this letter with a little bit of frustration and a lot of optimism.

We recognize that the Leadership Council is a volunteer position, and that all of you have various life, school, and work commitments that can impact your ability to participate in the council at the level you want to. Keeping this in mind, there is still a level of participation in the council that needs to occur. If there is an issue with you participating then there needs to be communication with us in its place.

The leadership council was asked to put together their own ideas for the actual rewrite of the Fed Code of Conduct. With multiple reminders and follow up – not a single member of the council sent in any work. Gabby and I are working hard to ensure that the Leadership council is 100% youth driven and that your opinions and feedback drive all of the work that we are doing. Our goal to keep the council youth focused and driven won't work if Gabby and I are working harder than the council.

During the council meeting on April 20<sup>th</sup> we will not be rewriting the Code of Conduct due to the fact that we did not receive the input we expected from the council. In its place we will have an open discussion about what accountability as a member of the Leadership Council looks like, and with your feedback if that needs to change. Perhaps the expectations we have of council members are unrealistic based on the time that each of you has to give.

At this point to keep the council moving forward Gabby and I will rewrite the Code of Conduct based on the feedback we received from you during our first council meeting in March.

We are so grateful for all of the time each of you are spending on the Leadership Council, and we honor you all for your commitment to helping us work towards our goal of keeping the Fed youth driven.
