

# MEDIA CONSENT POLICY

## GENERAL POLICY

The Federation of BC Youth in Care Networks and those acting as its authorized representatives (the Fed) have permission to reproduce, use, display, alter, distribute, and/or publish photos, videos, images and/or audio recordings of individuals taken for use in connection with the Fed's activities and programs, or to promote, publicize, market, or explain the Fed's goals, programs and/or activities, including publication or distribution to the public once permission is given by an individual

## POLICY & PROCEDURE DETAILS

An individual that agrees to media consent gives permission for the Fed without limitation and without reimbursement or payment of any kind, the right to publish and/or distribute the photos/videos/audio recordings, whether in digital or printed form, in any Fed-related publication, including but not limited to the following print or digital/online platforms

- Online social media platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube, etc.
- The Fed's website
- The Fed's e-news publications
- Presentations and Interviews
- Fundraising and events materials
- Power Pages Magazine
- Promotional materials such as brochures and information sheets
- Reports

If over 19 years of age, consent can be given by clicking an 'I agree' check box on a Fed Form.

If under 19 years of age, consent must be given in writing by completing our media consent form and both the individual and their guardian must sign.
