MEDICATION POLICY

POLICY OVERVIEW

The medication policy describes how medications are kept safe and administered during Fed events.

KEY INFORMATION

- Medication must be turned over to a Fed staff: As soon as you arrive at an event, you will need to hand all medication (prescription and non-prescription) over to a designated staff member. Exceptions: Birth Control, Epi-pens, Puffers.
 - The Fed cannot provide any medication, so if you need non-prescription meds like
 Tylenol or Advil, please bring them with you.
 - Youth over 19 who use Cannabis for medical reasons, can bring gummies/edibles based on BC health guidelines.
 - All medication should be in their original containers and labeled with your name, the name of medication, and the prescribed dosage.
- We will keep your medication safe: Medication will be kept in a locked bag and will be made
 available to you when you need it. This makes sure that no medication is lost or ends up in the
 wrong hands.
- **Take your medication on time:** It is your responsibility to take your medication on time as prescribed. Medication will be available based on dosage schedules.
- **Don't forget your medication when you leave:** It is your responsibility to pick up any remaining medication at the end of the event.
