WHO ARE PROGRAM PLANNERS?

We believe that youth in and from care bring an essential perspective to creating **POSITIVE EXPERIENCES** for their peers.

Program Planners are **VOLUNTEERS** who help plan program events and activities like celebrations, youth retreats and workshops.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS DO PROGRAM PLANNERS NEED?



All Program Planners have experience in government care in BC. It might be helpful for Program Planners to have experience or training in facilitation or event planning, but this isn't necessary.

WHAT ARE PROGRAM PLANNERS' DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES?

Come up with fun, safe and supportive event and program ideas for youth in and from care ages 14-24

Help ensure activities are inclusive of folks with different abilities, cultures and gender identities

Research different ideas and approaches

Come to regular planning meetings

Take on and complete work outside of planning meetings

Set up and take down event or program equipment or supplies

Help develop slideshows, presentations, scripts or other materials for participants or other volunteers

WHAT ABILITIES DO PROGRAM PLANNERS NEED?

Successful Program Planners are able to:

Collaborate with other volunteers and staff members

Understand and respect that other people might experience things differently than they do

Go with the flow and adapt to changing or unplanned situations



Be on time and keep their commitments as best they can, and if they can't, tell their supervising staff


Commit a good amount of time to volunteering (a few hours a week usually for a few weeks or a couple of months)

Lift 50 lbs for some opportunities (they might need to help set up for a program or event or move supplies or equipment)
